

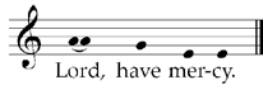
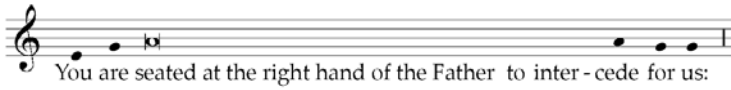
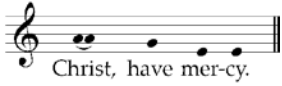
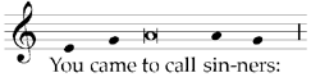
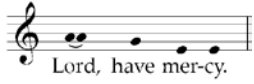
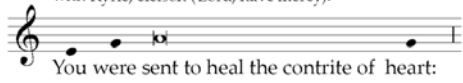
# A Sung Mass Card for Deacons

*At Sung Holy Mass, it is appropriate for the Deacon to sing the following:*


## THE PENITENTIAL ACT (option C)

The Priest, or a Deacon, or another minister, then sings the following or other invocations with Kyrie, eleison (Lord, have mercy):





At the end of the Gospel, the Deacon, or the Priest, acclaim:




The Gospel of the Lord.

Then, if appropriate, the Deacon, or the Priest, adds:




Let us offer each other the sign of peace.


