Timeline

February

- 12-13** “ANNOUNCEMENT WEEKEND” AT PARISHES
- 19-20** “Education/Kickoff Weekend” (Bishop’s recorded message or testimonials are given)
- 22** Bishop CFSA Letter is mailed to all households by Diocese
- 26-27** Commitment weekend at all parishes

March

- 12-13** Public Thank You and First Follow-up Weekend
To Parish Members and encouragement to participate in CFSA 2021
- 14-18** First Transmittal due in CFSA Office
First batch of completed pledge cards due at CFSA Office. Pledge cards separated into appropriate batches and parish check enclosed.

April

- 25-29** Second Transmittal due in CFSA Office
Second batch of completed pledge cards due at CFSA Office. Pledge Cards separated into appropriate batches and parish check enclosed.
- 23-24** Thank you and Second **Parish Follow-up, Telephone or Follow-up Letter**
Update parishioners on parish status and invite those who have not turned in pledge cards to prayerfully consider participating.

May

- 23-27** Third Transmittal due in CFSA Office
Third batch of completed pledge cards due at CFSA Office. Pledge cards separated into appropriate batches and parish checks enclosed.

June

- 20-24** Fourth Transmittal due in CFSA Office
Fourth batch of completed pledge cards due at CFSA Office. Pledge cards separated into appropriate batches and parish check enclosed.
- 20** Statement Letter sent to parishes with total pledges recorded and parish payment status

July

- 26** Final Transmittal End of Parish Campaign
- Diocesan phone/letter follow-up begins in September for those who have not responded or have nothing recorded at the diocese. Any response from parishioners needs to be communicated to the CFSA office. All pledges made to the diocese through this phase remains with the diocese. Notify CFSA Office of any exceptions.
